## The Analytical Services Program

The Office of Environment, Health, Safety and Security, Office of Sustainable Environmental Stewardship, manages the ASP, which is composed of three elements: the U.S. Department of Energy Consolidated Audit Program (DOECAP), the Mixed Analyte Performance Evaluation Program (MAPEP), and the Systematic Planning and Data Assessment Tools Program – Visual Sample Plan (VSP). Presentations and program reviews will be given on each component program of the ASP.

The ASP Workshop offers attendees a wide range of technical information and presentations based on commercial laboratory and waste treatment, storage, and disposal facility evaluations. DOE site status reports, audit checklist update information, and auditor/lead auditor training sessions are also provided. Representatives from agencies, such as the U.S. Department of Defense and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, also give presentations on interesting topics.
