What sites will come from, in what quantities, and in what form? 2) What type of NEPA documentation will DOE conduct on this additional 2 MT? (Note: Disposal of this material directly as waste without immobilization and radiation barrier) was not covered in the plutonium disposition EIS) 3) How will this material be blended for acceptance at WIPP and how much plutonium per container can be accepted into WIPP? 4) What is the “safeguards termination limit” for this plutonium 5) Which DOE department will pay for the disposal of this 2 MT at WIPP? As the plutonium has slated for disposal under an MD program, will MD now pay for all costs associated with disposal WIPP and will this cost be reflected in the life-cycle plutonium disposition cost? 6) Earlier, DOE had said that this 2 MT needed to meet the “spent fuel standard” for disposal but now no such argument is being presented. Given that no radiation barrier is necessary for disposal at WIPP, what is DOE’s justification for now not meeting the spent fuel standard for disposal of this plutonium? 7) Given disposal of this 2 MT of plutonium without meeting the spent fuel standard, and thus apparently a shift in DOE policy, would it not now be acceptable for DOE to dispose of all excess plutonium in WIPP, an expand WIPP, or a facility like WIPP? 8) Given this large increase in the amount of plutonium now slated for disposal at WIPP, is DOE now evaluating the necessity of safeguards at WIPP to protect against clandestine removal of drums containing plutonium or material from those drums? If not, why not?
