Dear Mr. Bearzi:

As required under Permit Condition IV.F.5.e, the Permittees are hereby notifying the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) of the loss of two (2) hydrogen and methane monitoring sampling lines.

The sampling lines involved were in Rooms 1 and 7 in Panel 3. These lines are identified as lines 1I and 7I. The line loss was discovered on July 14, 2008. Given the Panel 3 closure rates as determined by extensimeter measurements since operations ceased in Panel 3, the loss of some lines was not unexpected. The Permittees are evaluating the sampling line loss as required in Section N1-5b and will notify the NMED and stakeholder notification list when those evaluations are completed.

We certify under penalty of law that this document was prepared under our direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on our inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of our knowledge and belief true, accurate and complete.
