This position is considered to be within the scope of Attachment #1 Section 2.1 Quality Assurance Support of the subject task order. However, there was no corresponding labor category at the time of award to accommodate the work. This bilateral modification is also for the purpose of increasing the ceiling value of the Task Order based on past labor category additions or adjustments executed in the following modifications: Mod 008, 010, 023, 026, 029, 032, and 035.

A summary of the changes to this Task Order is provided below:
