Dear Mr. Kieling:

The purpose of this letter is to transmit notification of the loss of a hydrogen and methane monitoring system sampling line as required under Permit Condition 4.6.5.5. The sampling line that was lost is identified as line Panel 3 Room 6E, which is on the exhaust side of Room 6 in Panel 3. The line loss was discovered on October 10, 2012. The sample line loss will be evaluated per the requirements of Permit Attachment N1 Section N1-5b.

We certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under our direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted.
