ORGANIZATIONAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST (OCI) DISCLOSURE OR REPRESENTATION

It is the policy of Nuclear Waste Partnership LLC (NWP) to avoid situations which place an offeror in a position where its judgment may be biased because of any past, present, or currently planned interest, financial or otherwise, the offeror may have which relates to the work to be performed pursuant to this solicitation or where the offeror's performance of such work may provide it with an unfair competitive advantage. (As used herein, "offeror" means the proposer or any of its affiliates or proposed consultants or subcontractors of any tier.) Therefore:

- a) The offeror shall provide a statement which describes in a concise manner all relevant facts concerning any past, present or currently planned interest (financial, contractual, organizational, or otherwise) relating to the work to be performed hereunder and bearing on whether the offeror has a possible organizational conflict of interest with respect to:
 - 1) being able to render impartial, technically sound, and objective assistance or advice
 - 2) being given an unfair competitive advantage

The offeror may also provide relevant facts that show how its organizational structure and/or management systems limit its knowledge of possible organizational conflicts of interest relating to other divisions or sections of the organization and how that structure or system would avoid or mitigate such organizational conflict.

- In the absence of any relevant interest referred to above, the offeror shall submit a statement certifying that to
 its best knowledge and belief no such facts exist relevant to possible organizational conflicts of interest.
 Proposed consultants and subcontractors are responsible for submitting information and may submit it directly
 to the Department of Energy (DOE) with a copy of the transmittal letter to NWP.
- c. NWP will review the statement submitted and may require additional relevant information from the offeror. All such information, and other relevant information known to NWP and/or the DOE, will be used to determine whether an award to the offeror may create an organizational conflict of interest. If a conflict is found to exist, NWP and the DOE may
 - 1) Impose appropriate conditions which avoid such conflict
 - 2) Disqualify the offeror; or
 - 3) Determine that it is otherwise in the best interests of NWP and the government to contract with the offeror by including appropriate conditions mitigating such conflict in the subcontract.
- d. The refusal to provide the disclosure or representation and any additional information as required shall result in disqualification of the offeror for award. The nondisclosure or misrepresentation of any relevant interest may also result in the disqualification of the offeror for award, or if such nondisclosure or misrepresentation is discovered after award, the resulting subcontract may be terminated for default. The offeror may also be disqualified from subsequent related NWP and/or DOE subcontracts, and be subject to such other remedial action as may be permitted or provided by law or in the resulting subcontract. The attention of the offeror in complying with this provision is directed to 18 U.S.C. 1001.

- e. Depending on the nature of the subcontract activities, the offeror may, because of possible organizational conflicts of interest, propose to exclude specific kinds of work from the statement, unless the solicitation specifically prohibits such exclusion. Any such proposed exclusion by an offeror shall be considered by NWP in the evaluation of proposals, and if NWP considers the proposed excluded work to be an essential or integral part of the required work, the proposal may be rejected as unacceptable.
- f. No award shall be made until the disclosure or representation has been evaluated by NWP. Failure to provide the disclosure or representation will be deemed to be a minor informality (FAR 14-405) and the offeror or subcontractor shall be required to promptly correct the omission.
- g. (Do not complete both). Either statement shall be accompanied by a complete OCI questionnaire as provided at paragraph i., cited below.
